- Be a member of the National Forensic League
- Demonstrate good academic standing
- Exhibit team leadership
- Display a dedication to community service
- Uphold the NFL Code of Honor

The TFL Student of the Year will receive a \$200 cash award and a commemorative plaque. Each member school's coach may nominate ONE student for the award, and the TFL Executive Committee will convene during the State Tournament to review all applications and choose the recipient of the honor. Coaches must complete the attached ballot and return it to the TFL Vice-Chair at the address below (postmarked NO LATER THAN April 8, 2010) OR in person at registration for the State Tournament on April 16, 2010. Ballots received late will not be considered.
